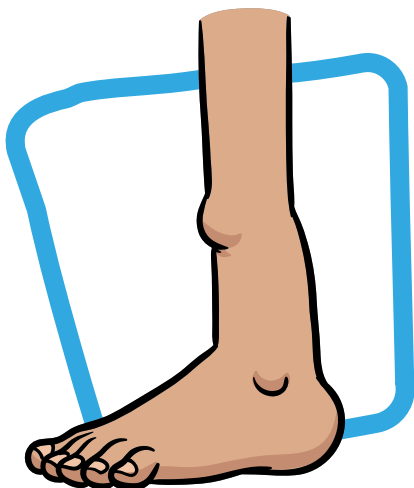
8 Facts about the Human Body

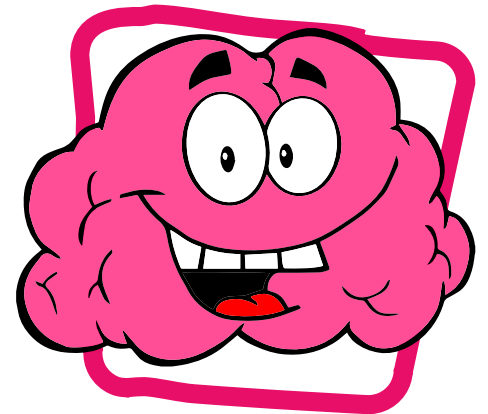
8 Facts about the Human Body
